

Activities Booklet Instructions



This Jack and the Beanstalk Activities Booklet uses characters and vocabulary from the *Once Upon a Sign* video *Jack and the Beanstalk in American Sign Language*. The booklet contains 12 different activities/worksheets to help enhance fun and increase learning for young viewers of this updated fairy tale, performed in American Sign Language (ASL).

WHAT IS ASL?

ASL is a language used for over two centuries by Deaf people in the United States and Canada. With every passing day, children at home, in daycare centers, and in classrooms are learning ASL from their parents, caretakers, and teachers.

DEPARTMENTS OF EDUCATION RECOGNIZE ASL

Now, states like California have Common Core Curriculum for Kindergarteners that includes teaching about ASL and the culture of Deaf people!

ASL FOSTERS EARLY LANGUAGE ACQUISITION AND LITERACY

ASL has healthy benefits for young children between the ages of 1-3 including building the language pathways in the brain, which accelerates the child's language comprehension. With this language acceleration, the child develops reading comprehension with a larger vocabulary at a younger age.

DIRECTIONS FOR THE ASL FOLDER

The following two pages are meant to be a front and back cover for students' ASL Folders. Print the pages out to glue on a folder or a manilla envelope that will hold the completed worksheets. The DawnSignKids logo page is the front, and there is space for students to add their name to the folder. On the back of the folder, glue the American Manual Alphabet as a guide for children to refer to so they can identify fingerspelled letters while working on the activities.









How to Draw Jack's Chicken



Start the chicken with an egg shape for the body.


With simple lines, build on the egg to make your own chicken.











Sign Language Opposites – Adjectives


